

Overall Goals - Increase environmental and financial resilience through social learning and connection

- 1. Increase successful adoption of climate resilient practices through development of individual farm climate resilience plans, farmer-to-farmer learning opportunities and mentorship.
- 2. Improve soil health practices through cohort learning from farmer-tofarmer relationships and peer-to-peer knowledge sharing; experienced mentors will guide developing expertise around soil health practices.
- 3. Increase farm financial resilience by providing financial and business planning resources to participants of the Farm Beginnings and Journeyperson Programs
