- 5. Conduct farm operations in a COVID-19 Environment



ANTICIPATED OUTPUTS

- Strengthen Program Ideas, Training Curricula, and hands-on material to apply for full grant
- Train 100 beginning farmers and initiate two the start of two new farms. Of those 100 beginning farmers, it is projected that at least 50% will be part of the socially disadvantaged and veteran groups.
- Generate more women beginning farmers by recruiting women farmer instructors from local women led farms.
