Mahia'ai Moa Project Poultry Farming

Project Goals and Objectives

To offer agricultural education and training programs that foster the growth and development of Chicken Poultry beginning farmers:

1. Poultry Farming Workshops

Participants will learn the basics of raising chicken broilers for market through a series of workshops and field trips.

2. UH CTAHR Feed & Foraging Workshops

One to two online classes to provide training on growing of food for chickens

3. Molokai Livestock Cooperative (MLC) Building Capacity & Training

Two in person trainings to ensure that our only local slaughterhouse is able to process chickens

Anticipated Outputs

Outputs will consist of the 3 trainings themselves, recruitment and training materials, and assistance in individualized farm setup, areas of production planning, business planning, and marketing

1. Poultry Farming Workshops

27 workshops and 6 field trips (in-person trainings) over 3 years; \$4,000 in farming supplies to each participant

2. UH CTAHR Feed & Foraging Workshops

3-6 workshops over three years

3. Molokai Livestock Cooperative (MLC) Building Capacity & Training

4 in-person trainings
